

Guidelines for Submitting a Manuscript for Review

1. Author (including co-author) must be a member of the Korean Institute of Power Electronics(hereafter KIFE) and comply with research ethics regulation in KIFE.
2. The manuscript is the original research paper in the field of power electronics and has not been announced on other publications. However, technology paper must be new technology or outcome of development of product in industries related to power electronics.
3. Manuscript is received at any time and the date of receipt of manuscript is the date when the manuscript arrives in KIFE.
4. Manuscript should be written in Korean or English. In manuscript written in Korean, English terms should be written in Korean. If necessary, English can be written in parentheses.
5. In English, the first letter of a sentence is in upper case and the rest should be in lower case. English used in Korean manuscript should be in lower case, which is in the principle. (However, proper nouns are the exception).
6. For English name, first name is written first and last name is followed (Ex: Gyu-Ha Choe and Hyung-Soo Mok)
7. Software to write the manuscript is HanGeul 97 or higher version. The manuscript for review should be printed out on A4 paper with proper size of font and line space to allow reviewers to take a look at them easily (Ex: font size of 11 point and line spacing of 180%). Title (Korean and English), abstract in English (100 -200 words), Keywords (4-5 words), main body, appendix and references are created in order according to paper/materials related to paper/ sample paper for submission in the homepage of KIFE. However, be careful not to reveal author and affiliation in the original Manuscript.
8. The Figures and Tables should be included in the text and captioned only in English. Figure captions should be placed at the bottom of the figures and the table captions should be at the top of the tables.
9. The size and color of the figures and the graphs, letters, numbers, etc included in the figures should be selected to be clear enough for black and white printing.
10. References must be written only in English in the order cited in the body of the manuscript.

11. Names of the journal and paper should be written in Italic. After paying the fee for paper review via electronic approval or deposit without a bankbook, the author should submit the manuscript created in PDF format through online paper review system(http://www.kipe.or.kr/paper/paper_guide.asp). The review fee is 40,000 KRW per paper for regular review and 120,000 KRW per paper for expedite review(Contact: Office of KIFE, Tel: +82-2-554-0184 ,Fax: +82-2-554-0186 , e-mail: pyunjip@kipe.or.kr)
12. The submitted manuscript is subject to review by editorial committee. Editorial committee may ask a partial revision or supplement of a manuscript.
13. After the manuscript is accepted, authors should submit a final manuscript file in HWP format for publication in accordance with "Guidelines for editing a final revised paper" based on "sample of final paper" on homepage of KIFE.
14. Papers will be published in the order of acceptance in review.
15. Publication fee (30,000 KRW per page up to 6 pages) will be imposed on all accepted papers. An extra page charge of 50,000 KRW per page will be charged on papers exceeding 7 pages. In case of expedite publication, additional 50% of the regular publication fee will also be imposed.
16. Copyright of paper published in the Transactions of Korean Institute of Power Electronics belongs to KIFE. The table, figure, etc. of the paper can be used under the permit of KIFE.
